PRINCIPAL'S REPORT: Mrs. Sarff would like our overall suggestion on keeping aftercare. We currently have 5 students who use the program. Consideration to require parents to set days of the week using the program and pay according to the days set. Someone being there everyday supports the provider's pay. For example, if I sign up for 3 days a week regardless if used I will pay for 3 days a week. This is not necessary for Aftercare as we have enough students using the program. After a brief discussion Fr. Andrejek said we need to keep supplying this service. The tuition grant currently states the 1st year is ½ off for those entering our school 1st - 8th grade and 2nd year a ¼ off tuition. We need to decide what to do when a student enters after the school year has started. The choices were to prorate and use the grant if the child is enrolled from August through December and if enrolled after December, prorate the tuition and apply the ½ off grant to the next school year. It was decided that we will give prorate from the start date and give ½ off the tuition, if the student starts before December. If the student starts after December the tuition will be prorated and they can use the ½ off tuition on the next school year. Please complete any updates to the Strategic Plan.

Phone sheets of family members that have not registered their children & Parish families of school age children were given to committee members to try to get them to choose our

school for their child's education or find out why they were not registered.
